

WICHITA COUNCIL OF ENGINEERING SOCIETIES

CONSTITUTION

Article I. Name

The name of this organization shall be known as the Wichita Council of Engineering Societies, a non-profit organization, hereinafter called the Council.

Article II. Purpose

The purpose of the council shall be:

- (a) To provide a vehicle of communication for promotion of the engineering professions.
- (b) To provide a forum for defining tasks and goals for the common benefit of all engineering societies.
- (c) To promote a general awareness of engineers and engineering to the Wichita and south central Kansas area.

Article III. Membership

Membership shall be available to those organizations in the Wichita area whose memberships are predominantly composed of persons engaged in engineering and promote the practice and the profession of engineering. Each member organization shall be hereinafter called Society.

Article IV. Representation

- (a) Each member society shall be represented by one delegate and one alternate. Date of appointment shall be at the option of member societies.
- (b) Each member society shall have one vote. Votes will be cast by the delegate or alternate.
- (c) Vacancies occurring in the representation of any society shall be filled immediately by the society.

Article V. Organization

The officers of the Council shall be at least a President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer. All officers shall be elected annually as provided in the Council By-Laws and shall be elected by the delegates at the Annual meeting. No one person may serve in the same office for more than two consecutive years.

Article VI. Finance

Funds necessary for the functioning of the Council shall be raised by means as determined by the delegates.

Article VII. By-Laws

The procedures of the Council and its committees shall be governed by the By-Laws.

Article VIII. Amendments

This constitution may be amended as follows:

- (a) All amendments shall be submitted in writing to the Council and distributed to each member Society, through its delegates, by the Council secretary at least ninety (90) days prior to the voting date.
- (b) Voting shall be by written ballot, one vote per each society, signed by the delegate or alternate. Ballots shall be distributed to the Society delegates fifteen (15) days prior to the voting date.
- (c) The Council may change this Constitution by an affirmative vote by three-fourths of the member organizations at a predetermined date.
- (d) Each member society shall be notified, in a written statement, of the official action, approval or disapproval, of any proposed amendment(s).

Article IX. Dissolution

Should the Council be dissolved for any reason whatever, all assets of whatever nature shall revert to the Engineering Student Council of The Wichita State University for use in promoting the Engineering Open House. The Council shall be considered dissolved if there is no activity within two calendar years.
